RCMP Quarterly Policing Report (Oct-Dec 2025)

A presentation was provided by Staff Sgt. S. Scott of the Salmon Arm RCMP Detachment summarizing policing activity from October to December 2025. The report outlined local crime trends, enforcement priorities, and community engagement initiatives during the reporting period.

Surveillance Cameras at Rainbow Crosswalk Locations

A staff report from the Corporate Officer outlined legislative and privacy considerations related to installing surveillance cameras at rainbow crosswalk locations. Based on current provincial privacy legislation and guidance, vandalism incidents do not meet the threshold required to justify municipal video surveillance. The report was received for information.

Development Permit – 3091 9 Avenue SW

Council approved the motion to authorize issuance of Development Permit No. 469 for 3091 9 Avenue SW, supporting development of a commercial highway service site. Issuance is subject to receipt of an Irrevocable Letter of Credit valued at 125% of the landscaping estimate to ensure completion of the landscaping plan. The motion carried.

Active Transportation Signage & Communication

An update was presented outlining proposed signage and communication initiatives to support walking, cycling, and other active transportation modes. The work includes community education, wayfinding improvements, and e-scooter safety awareness. The report was received for information.

Mt. Ida Wildfire Risk Reduction Program

Council approved the motion authorizing the Mayor and Corporate Officer to execute a Right of Way Agreement with the Ministry of Forests in support of the Mt. Ida Wildfire Risk Reduction Program, enabling wildfire mitigation work within designated areas.

Shuswap Recreation Society – User Fees & Rates

An overview of recreation user fees and rates was presented by the General Manager of the Shuswap Recreation Society. The report confirmed there are no rate increases for 2026, with programming fees continuing to follow cost-recovery models. Updates focus on structural changes and new fees associated with recently approved bookable recreation spaces.
